



Statement on the use of Drones on, from, and over Club Premises.

Drones are an increasingly popular pastime for some, and an annoyance for others.

Members are reminded that the Bowbrook facility is primarily a venue for Members to enjoy Archery.

Should any member wish to use a drone at the Field, they must ensure *everyone* present is happy with this before setting the equipment up. One member declining means the equipment cannot be used. The permission of our near neighbours must also be sought, as a matter of courtesy, prior to launch.

Should the drone carry a camera / recording device, this must be pointed out clearly. As per the Clubs Photography approach, should footage be used on any social media etc. site, participants' permission will be sought where they are clearly identifiable. If they are unavailable, or refuse, the footage must be edited, or not posted.

The drone must not, at any time, be flown less than 100' above the range.

The User must have some kind of (evidenced) third party insurance cover, in case of damage to buildings, vehicles, equipment, or individuals.
